No great change occurred on top ten tables during the seventh round. Only Vitiugov and Wojtasjek could win as white and so Potkin stays all alone on the top of the standings. For the last four rounds, a great fight is expected, as super grandmasters are about to be back in the business: Svidler, Nepomniachtchi, Navara, Jakovenko, and Judit Polgar (with a win in great style over Pantsulaia) won their games and reached the "5 points" group.

With energetic play, typical of that generation of grandmasters and particularly Wojtaszek, white has reached a dream position, leaving black pratically in zugzwang in the middle game.
